Payment Options

Fee account statements are sent to families via email in the first week of each school term. Additional fee balances can be viewed on the Compass Portal for payment. Term fees are payable in full by the due date each term unless an approved direct debit is set up through the College.

For your convenience, the College currently provides several flexible payment options:

Option 2: Direct Debit arrangement through the College

- Recurrent Credit Card and Direct Debits can be set up on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis
